- Transitioned to CMH March 2017
- 46 homes with support services
- 8 full-time mental health workers and nurse*
- Outreach Team is available Sunday to Saturday at this location

Royal Crescent 22548 Royal Crescent Avenue

- Opened October 2018
- 53 homes with support services
- 14 full-time mental health workers and nurse*
- Daily meal and breakfast
- Community programming**





Garibaldi Ridge 11749 Burnett Street

- Opened September 2019
- 51 homes with support including 16 full-time mental health workers and nurse*
- · Daily meal and breakfast
- Community programming**
- *Staff supports are available 24hrs/7days a week, including a range of inpatient and outpatient supports with Fraser Health.
 ** This includes volunteering, employment opportunities and social connections.



COMPASSION, COURAGE, RECOVERY

All our tenants are encourage to work with CMH staff to set goals and access appropriate health services.

- · Psychiatric treatment
- Rehabilitation and recovery
- · Reconnecting with a local doctor
- Residential treatment programs:
 - detox and day treatment programs
 - drug and alcohol counselling
 - · mental health teams and services
- Referral to local Health Authorities for higher levels of care

- A member of CMH Street Clean Team gains employment with a local construction company.
- A female tenant completes her Safe Serve Food Certification and gains job-ready skills working alongside our cook at Royal Cresent.
- In June 2019, 75 people (tenants, Maple Ridge residents, volunteers and staff) enjoyed a neighbourhood barbeque at Royal Crescent.

COMMUNITY SAFETY

- 24/7 onsite Mental Health Workers
- Tenant selection is based on ability to provide the right level of support to all
- Regular inspections of the property
- Signed tenancy agreement or program agreement and a crime-free addendum
- Optimized lighting, security cameras, fob access only, staffed-run reception, and a contained outdoor space for smoking
- Community Advisory Committee with representatives from BC Housing, Fraser Health, local service providers, supportive housing residents, RCMP and first responders, and selected community members
